Conditions of Entry for DMIA W.A. State Dance Medalist Pageant

Age Definition

Your age on the 3rd December 2017 will determine your age category
Open to medallist and recreational competitors.

Tri-style Competitions

Juvenile	Both competitors must be under 13yrs. of age
Junior	Both competitors must be 13yrs, 14yrs. or 15yrs. of age
Adult	Both competitors must be 16yrs or over.
Senior	Both competitors must be 35yrs. or over

Parent and own Child

The adult partner may be parent grandparent or legal guardian.
Professionals teachers are excluded from these events

Open Medallist Events

Medallists and Recreational competitors must be partnered by person of the same age division
Only Medallists and Recreational dancers may dance in these events
Must not be partnered by a Professional, Teacher or a person who has competed in DSA graded events

Open Street Latin

Is open to all Medallists and Recreational competitors.
Competitors must dance in their correct age section
Juvenile/ Junior section medalist must be aged less than 16yrs
Adult/ Senior section must be 16yrs or over
Competitors must be partnered by another medalist, No Professionals, teachers or a person who has competed in DSA graded events to partner competitors in these events

Rock N Roll

Coaches, Professionals, teaches or a person who has competed in DSA graded events
may not dance in this events

Teams Match

Juvenile/ Junior team all competitors must be under 16yrs of age
Three Couples per team (Six competitors)
Team may consist of any combination of couples boy/ girl or two girls. couples
Adult /Senior Teams all competitors must be 16yrs. and over
Couples may consist of male/female or two females
Studio Principal, teachers or a person who has competed in DSA graded events may not dance in this event

- 1 Competitor must have no higher medal or equivalent than the level of the event in which they are entering . Each style considered separately, Medallist may be danced at a higher level in their division where necessary to accommodate all medalists at Studio Principals discretion
- 2 Competitor may dance with a professional or amateur partner. Except where stated otherwise
- 3 Each couple must consists of one Medallist or Recreational and a partner
- 4 Competitor **must dance within restricted syllabus** for grades lower than silver cross, silver star, or silver bar events
- 5 Competitor **must not** be currently registered as a graded competitor with Dancesport Australia or the Australian Dance Board
- 6 Street dress for competitor and partner.(off the Rack) **Minimum sequins, no DanceSport dresses**
- 7 Anyone who is **paid to teach** is not permitted to dance as a competitor
- 8 Competitors are restricted to one event in each style, plus the Open events .
- 9 By entering any event you have agreed to abide by the rules and conditions of entry as set down by Dance Masters International Association INC.
- 10 Dance Masters International Association reserve the right of absolute discretion in **All decisions**
- 11 All competitors and spectators agree by attending this event, to have their photograph or digital image taken by the DMIA official Photographers. In the event of television coverage, production of a video recording and including any still photographs or digital image taken during the event, may be used for commercial purposes . All competitors agree that the rights to all fees from such recordings will vest with Dance Masters International Association Inc.
