Conditions of entry for July Dance Pageant

DSA Registered Recreational Dancers

As Medalist events are now classified as Novelty Events by DSA, Registered Recreational Competitors may dance in any event that is their age group and medal level. They may be partnered by their Competitive partner or anyone who meets the criteria for that particular event

Medalists competitors

Competitor must have no higher medal or equivalent than the level of the event in which they are entering. Each style considered separately, Medalist may be danced at a higher level in their division where necessary to accommodate all medalists from a studio at principal's discretion

Tri-style Competitions

Juvenile	Both competitors must not have turned 13yrs. of age
Junior	Both competitors must be between 13yrs. and less than 16yrs.
Youth Adult	Both competitors must be 16yrs. and over
Masters	Both competitors must be 35yrs and over.

Parent and own Child

The adult partner may be parent grandparent or legal guardian.
Coaches, Professionals and Dance Teachers are excluded from these events

Open Medalist Events

Medalists must be partnered by person of the same age division
Competitors must be partnered by another medalist, **No** Coaches, Professionals or Dance Teachers to partner competitors in these events

Open Street Latin

Competitors must dance in their correct age section
Juvenile/ Junior section medalist must be aged less than 16yrs
Adult/ Masters section must be 16yrs or over
Competitors must be partnered by another medalist, **No** Coaches, Professionals or Dance Teachers to partner competitors in these events

Rock N Roll

Coaches, Professionals or Teaches may not dance in this event

Teams Match (Six competitors per team)

Juvenile / Junior team all competitors must be under 16yrs
Three Couples per team
Team may consist of either combination of couples boy/ girl or two girl's couples
Adult /Senior Teams all competitors must be 16yrs. and over
Couples may consist of male/female or two females
Coaches, Professionals and teachers may not dance in these events

Medalists

- 1 Competitor must have no higher medal or equivalent than the level of the event in which they are entering. Each style considered separately, Medalist may be danced at a higher level in their division where necessary to accommodate all medalists from a studio at principal's discretion
- 2 Competitor may dance with a professional or amateur partner. Except where stated otherwise
- 3 Each couple must consists of one medalist and a partner
- 4 Competitor **must dance within restricted syllabus** for grades lower than 2nd Silver(DMIA Silver Cross, Silver Star, or Silver Bar) events
- 5 Street dress for competitor and partner.(off the Rack), **no DanceSport dresses unless dancing in 2nd gold and above**
- 6 **Anyone who is paid to teach is not permitted to dance as a competitor**
- 7 **Competitors** are restricted to one event in each style, plus the Open events.
- 8 **By** entering any event you have agreed to abide by the rules and conditions of entry as set down by Dance Masters International Association INC.
- 9 Dance Masters International Association Inc. Reserve the right of absolute discretion in **All decisions**
- 10 All competitors or spectators agree by attending this event, to have their photograph or digital image taken by the DMIA official Photographers. In the event of television coverage, production of a video recording and including any still photographs or digital image taken during the event, may be used for commercial purposes. All competitors agree that the rights to all fees from such recordings will vest with Dance Masters International Association Inc.

This event is registered with the Australian Dancing Board competitors should be registered with the Australian Dancing Board. Registration officer Pat Thomson will be present on day of event to take registrations.
